ORDINANCE NO. 290

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAILER COACHES AND OTHER VEHICLES DESIGNED FOR DWELLING OR SLEEPING PURPOSES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to maintain a trailer coach or other vehicle which is constructed or designed for dwelling or sleeping purposes upon any private or public property in the Town when the same is used for sleeping or living purposes, unless the property is licensed as a trailer park.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful to park or permit to stand any trailer coach or other vehicle which is constructed or designed for dwelling or sleeping purposes upon any public street or alley for a period longer than twenty-four (24) hours, and no such trailer coach or other such vehicle shall be used for dwelling or sleeping purposes while parked in any such place.

Section 3. Any person who shall be convicted of a violation of this ordinance shall be fined in a sum of not less than One (\$1.00) Dollar nor more than Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars, or imprisoned for a term not exceeding ninety (90) days for each offense. Where any violation is a continuing offense, each day that the violation continues shall be considered and held to be a separate and different offense.

Section 4. The Board of Trustees herewith finds, determines and designates that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and whereas in the opinion of the Board of Trustees an emergency exists, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its final passage, adoption and publication.
