

ORDINANCE NO. 285

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3 (a), SCHEDULE III, SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 237 OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO:

Section 1. That Section 3 (a), Schedule III, Section 1 of Ordinance No. 237 of the Town of Berthoud, Colorado, be and the same is hereby amended to read:

Section 1. - - Through streets.- - In accordance with the provisions of Section 155 and when signs are erected giving notice thereof, drivers of vehicles shall stop at every intersection before entering any of the following streets or parts of streets:

Name of street	Portions Affected
Fourth Street	Mountain Avenue to Franklin Avenue Capitol Avenue to North Town limits
Mountain Avenue	From East Town limits to West Town limits.

Section 2. The Board of Trustees herewith finds, determines and designates that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and whereas in the opinion of the Board of Trustees an emergency exists, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its final passage, adoption and publication.
