ORDINANCE NO. 1267

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NUMBER 237 OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO, RELATING TO TRAFFIC.

Be it Ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud Colorado:

Section 1. That Section 3 (a), SCHEDULE I, Section 4, of Ordinance Number 237 of the Town of Berthoud, entitled Decrease of State Law Maximum Speed, be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

It is hereby determined upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation that the speed permitted by State Law as applicable on the following streets is greater than reasonable or safe under conditions found to exist on such streets and it is hereby declared that the *prima facie* speed limits shall be as herein set forth on the streets and parts of streets herein designated, at the times and under the conditions herein specified:

Name of Street	Prima facie speed limit	Times
Mass. Ave. between 6th St. and 7th Street; 6th and 7th Streets between Mt. Ave and Mass. Ave.	15	From 8:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M. on school days; during public gatherings at Dist. 13 JT Public school and for one-half hour before and after such gatherings, when signs are erected giving notice thereof.
Street in Town Park	15	At all times
All other streets except Mountain Ave.	25	At all times

Section 2. It being necessary that traffic be regulated on the streets of the Town of Berthoud, in the opinion of the Board of Trustees, an emergency exists and this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon the expiration of five days from and after its passage and publication.
