

ORDINANCE NO. 250

Relating to the Licensing of Persons Engaged in Plumbing.

Be It Ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Nerthoud, Colo.:

Section 1. The word "person" as used herein shall mean any individual, firm, company, association, society, corporation or group.

Section 2. No person shall be allowed to do any plumbing work in the Town of Berthoud, except on his own property, until such person shall obtain a license from the Board of Trustees, which license shall be issued by the Town Clerk, to operate and carry on the trade of a plumber. The Board may grant such a license to any person who has been so licensed by the Colorado State Board of Health, or who has an employee or member who has been so licensed. The Board may revoke said license at any time by giving notice to such person of such revocation, and he shall then cease to do any plumbing work in said Town. Any person licensed or to be licensed as aforesaid as a plumber shall, before receiving such license or doing any work as such plumber, pay to the Town Clerk such sum as the Board may from time to time, by Resolution, prescribe for a license for one year. No such license shall be transferrable and no refund shall be allowed for part of a year.

Section 3. Any person violating this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be fined not less than five dollars nor more than fifty dollars, and each day of the continuance of a violation of this Ordinance shall be deemed a separate violation.

Section 4. So much of Ordinance Number 161 as relates to plumbers is hereby repealed.
