Repealing Certain Ordinances and Parts of Ordinances.

Be It Ordained By The Board Of Trustees Of The Town of Berthoud, Colo:

THAT the following Ordinances and parts of Ordinances be, and the same are hereby, repealed:

Ordinance No. 6 in Relation to the Fire Department, dated October 13, 1888;

Sections 6 and 7 of Ordinance No. 8 Defining the Duties of the Marshal, dated October 13, 1888;

Sections 1, 3, 4 and 6 of Ordinance No. 9 Defining the Duties of the Street Supervisor, dated October 13, 1888;

Sections 5, 9, 11, 12, 13 and 19 of Ordinance No. 13 in Relation to Procedure, dated December 18, 1888;

Section 1 of Ordinance No. 24 Concerning Stock, Pigs and Fowls, dated March 25, 1890;

Ordinance No. 40 in Relation to Physicians and Contagious Diseases, dated March 14, 1893;

Sections 1 and 2 of Ordinance No. 95 Relating to the Running of Trains and the Blockading of Streets within the Corporate Limits of the Town of Berthoud, dated March 18, 1904;

Ordinance No. 180 Relating to Safety Appliances at the Railroad Crossing on Mountain Avenue, dated May 13, 1924.
