

ORDINANCE NO. 246

Making Appropriation For the Fiscal Year Beginning April 1, 1955.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud:

Section 1. That the following named sums for the following named purposes be and are hereby appropriated to defray the necessary expenses and liabilities of the Town of Berthoud for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 1955:

FIRST - For water works the sum of \$10,000.00 for repairing, extensions and current expenses of the water department.

SECOND - For interest on water bonds the sum of \$4,575.00.

THIRD - For redemption of water bonds the sum of \$5,555.00.

FOURTH - For streets, alleys, ditches and sewers, the sum of \$9,500.00 for the construction and repair of the streets, avenues alleys, bridges, culverts, sidewalks, crosswalks and ditches, and for the repair and incidental expenses of the sewers now constructed or which may be hereafter constructed, or for the lighting of the streets.

FIFTH - For the Park Fund the sum of \$1,500.00 for payment of any liabilities of the Town in connection with the municipal Park and recreation grounds, and for the improvements, maintenance and cost of caring for said Park and grounds.

SIXTH - For the Cemetery Fund the sum of \$2,580.00 for the payment of any expenses and liabilities of the Town in connection with the cemetery.

SEVENTH - For the Contingent Fund the sum of \$6,000.00 for the payment of any expenses and liabilities of the Town not hereinbefore provided for.
