### ORDINANCE NO. 242

An Ordinance Providing for the Submission of the Question of paying Compensation to the Mayor and Members of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud to the Vote of the Legal Voters of Said Town at the general Election on April 6, 1954.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud:

Section 1. That at the regular municipal election of the Town of Berthoud to be held on April 6, 1954, the following question be submitted to a vote:

"Shall the Mayor and members of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud be paid five (\$5.00) dollars each for each attendance at a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees."

Section 2. That all legal voters of the said Town shall be qualified to vote on the said question.

Section 3. The Town Clerk shall give notice of the submission of the question provided for in Section 1 of this Ordinance at the same time and in the same manner as the notice of the said municipal election.

Section 4. That an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance is declared to be necessary to the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and shall be in full force and effect five days after its publication.
