

ORDINANCE NO. 239

An Ordinance Amending Article IV of Ordinance No. 22, as Amended, to Require Vaccination of Dogs for Rabies and Changing the Cost of Licenses.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD:

Section 1. THAT Section 1 of Article IV of Ordinance No. 22, as amended, of the Town of Berthoud, be amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. Any person desiring to keep a dog within the Town of Berthoud may be permitted to do so by paying a license to the Town Clerk of \$1.00 per annum for each male dog, and \$5.00 per annum for each female dog so proposed to be kept."

Section 2. THAT said Article IV of Ordinance No. 22, as amended, of the Town of Berthoud, be further amended by adding thereto the following:

"Section 5. No license shall be issued by the Town Clerk under this article unless the applicant for such license presents a certificate from a licensed Veterinarian that the dog to be licensed has been vaccinated for rabies within the preceding twelve (12) months."

Section 3. That an emergency is declared to exist and this Ordinance is declared to be necessary to the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and shall go into effect immediately after its passage and final publication.
