

ORDINANCE NO. 230

Relating to Parking on Certain Streets in the Town of Berthoud.

Be It Ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud:

Section 1. THAT from and after the passing of this Ordinance and the publication thereof, it shall be unlawful for any person to park any automobile or other power driven vehicle for a period exceeding one hour on the following named streets or avenues in the Town of Berthoud: On the north side and south side of Mountain Avenue, between Third and Fourth Streets, and on the west side of Third Street, between Mountain Avenue and Massachusetts Avenue, except Sundays, Holidays, and between the hours of 6:00 P.M. and 9:00 A.M.

Section 2. Any person found guilty of violating any of the terms of this Ordinance shall be fined in a sum not less than \$2.00 nor more than \$10.00.
