

ORDINANCE No. 229

An Ordinance Making Appropriation for the Payment of Construction Costs of the Water Works System for which Provision has not heretofore been made.

WHEREAS, it has developed that the funds realized from a bond issue authorized for the construction of a new water works system are insufficient to pay the full costs thereof and additional funds are required therefor in order to meet obligations which will currently become due; and

WHEREAS, this emergency has arisen since the passage of the annual appropriation ordinance for the present fiscal year, and in the opinion of the Board of Trustees the situation constitutes a casualty within the meaning of the statutes of the State of Colorado, now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud:

That, for the purpose of paying the construction costs of the new water works system of the Town for which no provision has heretofore been made there is hereby created a special fund to be known as the "Water Works Construction Emergency Fund" there hereby is appropriated for said fund the sum of \$15,000 and all warrants drawn in payment of said construction costs shall be endorsed "Water Works Construction Emergency Fund" and a separate account kept thereof by the Town Clerk and the Town Treasurer.
