ORDINANCE NO. 222

Relating to the Purchase of The Town of Berthoud Reservoir, and
Making an Appropriation Therefor.

Whereas, under the terms of the existing contract with the present owner of The Town of Berthoud Reservoir for the use thereof for the storage of water therein, it is found that it is impossible to store a sufficient amount of water to serve the needs of the citizens of the Town of Berthoud at such times as a direct flow from the river is unavailable, and there is an immediate need for additional water which can be obtained only by the purchase of said reservoir and making it a part of the present water works system of the Town; and,

Whereas, the necessity for said addition to said water works system has arisen since the annual appropriation required by law, the above-mentioned casualty happening thereafter; Therefore,

Be It Ordained By The Board Of Trustees Of The Town Of Berthoud:

That for the purpose of paying the cost of said reservoir, there be and hereby is created a special fund to be known as "Water Works Extension Fund," and there be and hereby is appropriated for said fund the sum of ten thousand (\$10,000.00) dollars, and all warrants drawn in payment of the purchase price of said reservoir shall be endorsed "Water Works Extension Fund," and a separate account thereof kept by the Town Clerk and Town Treasurer.

Passed and adopted this 9th day of April, A.D., 1946.
