

ORDINANCE No. 218

MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING APRIL 1, 1943.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud:

Section 1. THAT the following named sums for the following named purposes be and are hereby appropriated to defray the necessary expenses and liabilities of the Town of Berthoud for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 1943:

FIRST- - For water works and fire department, the sum of \$5,000.00, for repairs, extensions and current expenses of the water works department and for purchasing of hose, and for the necessary expenses of the fire department.

SECOND- - For interest on water bonds, the sum of \$900.00.

THIRD- - For redemption of water bonds, the sum of \$2,500.00.

FOURTH- - For streets, alleys, ditches and sewers, the sum of \$5,000.00, for the construction and repair of the streets, avenues, alleys, bridges, culverts, sidewalks, crosswalks and ditches and for the repair and incidental expenses of the sewers now constructed or which may be hereafter constructed, or for the lighting of the streets.

FIFTH- - For the Park Fund, the sum of \$1,000.00.

SIXTH- - For the contingent fund, the sum of \$4,000.00 for the payment of any expenses and liabilities of the Town of Berthoud not hereinabove provided for.
