

ORDINANCE NO. 398

AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING CHAPTER 17 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO, BY ADDING SUBSECTION 17.35, RAILROAD--SPEED LIMITS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1.

That Chapter 17 of the Municipal Code of the Town of Berthoud, Colorado be and the same is hereby modified to incorporate Subsection 17.35 which reads as follows:

17.35 RAILROADS - RAILROAD SPEED LIMITS. It shall be unlawful for any person to move, propel or run any railroad tractor, locomotive or other railway vehicle at a speed greater than 20 miles per hour on any track in the Town of Berthoud.

Section 2.

The Board of Trustees herewith finds, determines and designates that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety; and whereas in the opinion of the Board of Trustees an emergency exists, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately after its final passage and adoption.

This Ordinance was introduced, read, passed on first reading and ordered published by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud at its regular meeting held this 26th day of November, 1974.
