

ORDINANCE NO. 389

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 6 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO, BY AMENDING CHAPTER 6, SUBSECTION 6.11 RELATING TO THE DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1.

That Chapter 6, Subsection 6.11 of the Municipal Code of the Town of Berthoud, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Any Consumer who desires to discontinue the use of water shall file written notice with the Town Clerk and pay all current and back charges for water used.

During the period of discontinuance of service there shall be no charges or fees, however, upon continuance of service by re-occupancy or otherwise the owner shall notify the Town Clerk within ten days and failure so to do shall cause the charges and fees to relate back to the time of the discontinuance of service and shall have the same force and effect as if the service had continued without interruption.

Section 2.

The Board of Trustees herewith finds, determines and designates that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety; and whereas in the opinion of the Board of Trustees an emergency exists, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately after its final passage and adoption on the 13 day of February, 1974.
