

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS IN EXCESS OF THE 1973 BUDGET.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO:

Section 1. The purpose of the ordinance is to authorize the expenditure of the sum of \$5,200 from the Contingency Funds of the Town of Berthoud for the year 1973.

Section 2. During the year 1973, the Town was compelled to spend to overhaul its D-8 Caterpillar which it did not anticipate at the time the budget was adopted in 1972.

Section 3. Wherefore pursuant to the provisions of CRS 1963 88-1-12 and 88-1-15, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud hereby authorizes the expenditures from the Contingency Fund appropriated in the 1973 Budget, the sum of \$5,200.

Section 4. The Board of Trustees herewith determines and designates that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and whereas, in the opinion of the Board of Trustees an emergency exists, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately after its final passage, adoption and publication.

The above ordinance was passed on first reading and adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud, Colorado, at its regular meeting held Tuesday, December 11, 1973, with all trustees voting for the adoption of this ordinance and 0 trustees voting against the adoption of this ordinance. That said vote therefor meets the requirement that the ordinance be adopted by two-thirds vote of the Board of Trustees.

The Town Clerk of hereby directed to send a certified copy of this ordinance to be filed with the Div. of Local Gov't. and published in full one time in a newspaper having general circulation within the limits of the Town of Berthoud.
