

ORDINANCE

347

AN ORDINANCE REQUESTING AN AMENDMENT TO THE BUDGET FOR 1972 BE APPROVED BY THE STATE OF COLORADO, DEPARTMENT OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO:

Section 1. The purpose of this Ordinance is to request of the State of Colorado, Department of Local Government, the approval of an amendment to the 1972 budget of the Town of Berthoud, Larimer County, Colorado, from \$10,700.00 estimated cash surplus to \$23,720.00 cash surplus.

Section 2. In September 1971 when the Town drew up its budget for 1972, it estimated its cash surplus at the end of the year in the sum of \$10,700.00. When the Town received its audit in May of 1972 for the year of 1971, the audit showed a cash surplus of \$23,720.00. The Town's budget was based on a surplus of \$10,700.00 leaving a balance of \$13,020.00 unappropriated for 1972. Wherefore, the Town hereby requests an amendment to its 1972 budget to include said \$13,020.00, thereby leaving a cash surplus of \$23,720.00.

Section 3. The reason for this request, under law made and provided, is that the Town had to install curb, gutter and sidewalk to the new gradeschool in the amount of \$8,000.00. Furthermore, the Town was required to install curb, gutter and oil mat in a new subdivision for the total sum of \$5,020.00. Total amount of these items, \$13,020.00. In the fiscal year 1971 the Town adopted its 1972 budget without anticipating these aforesaid expenditures. Wherefore, the Town requests this Ordinance requesting an amendment to its 1972 budget be accepted whereby the 1972 budget of the Town of Berthoud hereinafter read \$23,720.00 cash surplus.

Section 4. The Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud herewith finds, determines and designates that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety; and whereas, in the opinion of the Board of Trustees, an emergency exists, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately after its final passage, adoption and publication.

This ordinance was introduced, read, passed on first reading and ordered published by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud at its special meeting held this 26 day of September, 1972.
