

ORDINANCE NO. 366

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS IN EXCESS OF THE 1972 BUDGET FROM THE CONTINGENCY FUND.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO:

Section 1. The purpose of this ordinance is to authorize the expenditure of the sum of \$4,580.00 from the Contingency Fund of the Town of Berthoud for the year 1972.

Section 2. In 1972 the Town built a new clarifier at its water plant which compelled the Town to employ an additional employee in the amount of \$3,380.00. Furthermore, due to the increase work load in the administration office, the Town was constrained to employ a part-time clerk in the amount of \$1,200.00. Total amount of these expenditures is the sum of \$4,580.00 which is available in the contingency fund.

Section 3. Wherefore, pursuant to the provisions of CRS 1963 88-1-12 and 88-1-15, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud hereby authorizes the expenditure from the contingency fund appropriated in the 1972 budget of \$4,580.00.

Section 4. The Board of Trustees herewith determines and designates that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety; and whereas, in the opinion of the Board of Trustees an emergency exists, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately after its final passage, adoption and publication.

This ordinance was introduced, read, passed on first reading and ordered published by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud at its special meeting held this 26 day of September, 1972.
