

ORDINANCE NO. 340

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 16 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO, BY AMENDING CHAPTER 16, SUB-SECTION 3 RELATING TO THE BURNING OF COMBUSTIBLE REFUSE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO:

Section 1. That Chapter 16 of the Municipal Code of the Town of Berthoud, Colorado be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

16.3. Burning of Wastes Unlawful. No person shall burn or permit to be burned on any open premises owned or controlled by him or on any public street, alley or other land adjacent to such premises, any rubbish, waste paper, wood or other flammable material, unless a permit therefor shall first have been obtained from the appropriate state authority enforcing air pollution control standards and from the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud, Colorado.

Section 2. The Board of Trustees herewith finds, determines and designates that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety; and whereas in the opinion of the Board of Trustees an emergency exists, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately after its final passage and adoption.
