

ORDINANCE NO. 335

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 19 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO, BY ADDING THERETO NEW SUBSECTIONS TO ARTICLE II, SECTION 2, SAID AMENDMENT RELATING TO THE REGULATION OF TRAFFIC AT INTERSECTIONS CONTROLLED BY TRAFFIC CONTROL LIGHTS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD,
COLORADO:

Section 1. That Chapter 19 of the Municipal Code of the Town of Berthoud, Colorado, be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto the following subsections:

§ 19.2.3. No right turn on red signal when. No right turn shall be permitted at any intersection within the limits of the Town of Berthoud at a time when any traffic control light at said intersection indicates red when a traffic control sign is posted at said intersection prohibiting a right turn on red. Said sign shall bear the words "no right turn on red" and shall be posted in a conspicuous place at or near the traffic control signal light.

§ 19.2.4. Exception. The provisions of this ordinance shall not apply to authorized emergency vehicles.

§ 19.2.5. Penalties. Every person convicted of a violation of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine not exceeding \$300.00 or by imprisonment not exceeding thirty days or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 2. The Board of Trustees hereby finds, determines and designates that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety; and whereas in the opinion of the Board of Trustees an emergency exists, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately after its final passage and adoption.
