

ORDINANCE NO. 327

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS IN EXCESS OF 1967 BUDGET

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO:

Section 1. In the month of November in the year of 1967, the Town Board of Trustees received a gift of 20 shares of stock from R. B. Fickel, a citizen of the Town of Berthoud. Said gift was made for the purpose of paying for ^{all materials for} an equipment garage to be constructed for the Town of Berthoud. The equipment garage used by the Town of Berthoud in the past had been inspected and it was determined that the structure was in a state of collapse; that repair work on the structure would not be warranted; that the structure was in such a condition that it would not be satisfactory for the storage of equipment for the Town of Berthoud; nor could the structure be used to allow proper maintenance of the town equipment. The Town Board believes that this is a contingency which could not have reasonably been foreseen at the time of the adoption of the 1967 budget and that emergency exists requiring the construction of a new equipment garage.

Section 2. Under the provisions of C.R. S. 1963, 88-1-15 the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud hereby authorize the expenditure of funds in excess of the 1967 budget in the amount of \$ 4065.25.

Section 3. The Board of Trustees herewith determines and designates that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and whereas, in the opinion of the Board of Trustees an emergency exists, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its final passage and adoption and publication.

The above ordinance was passed on first reading and adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud, Colorado, at its regular meeting held Tuesday, December 12, 1967 with 5 trustees voting for the adoption of this ordinance and 0 trustees voting against the adoption of this ordinance. That said vote therefore meeting the requirement that the ordinance be adopted by two-thirds vote of the Board of Trustees.

The Town Clerk is hereby directed to send a certified copy of this Ordinance to be filed with the State Tax Commission and published in full one time in a newspaper having general circulation within the limits of the Town of Berthoud.
