

ORDINANCE NO. 326

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS IN EXCESS OF 1967
BUDGET

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN
OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO:

Section 1. In the year 1967 the Town Board of Trustees contracted with the United States Government and received advances from the United States Government in the amount of Nine Thousand Dollars (\$9,000.00). The Board of Trustees by resolution approved the use of the services of attorney, Frank Starkey, regarding the United States Federal Advance for Public Works. The engineering firm of Nelson, Haley, Patterson and Quirk have performed studies under the agreement with the United States Government. Attorney Frank Starkey has advised the Board that the engineering firm has completed its studies and is entitled to the \$9,000.00 as provided for under the agreement with the United States Government and that the money should be disbursed as follows: Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000.00) for street studies; One Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$1,800.00) for water study and One Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$1,200.00) for sewer study. The Town Board believes that this is a contingency which could not have reasonably been foreseen at the time of the adoption of the 1967 budget and that an emergency exists inasmuch as the engineering firm has performed the services to the satisfaction of Mr. Frank Starkey serving as special counsel for the Town of Berthoud.

Section 2. The Board of Trustees agreed to construct a water line to a parcel of land that was annexed to the Town of Berthoud in the year of 1967. The Town Board believes that this is a contingency which could not have reasonably been foreseen at the time of the adoption of the 1967 budget and that emergency exists requiring the construction of the water line to the annexed property. The cost of constructing the new water line is Two Thousand Six Hundred Ninety-four Dollars and Fourteen Cents (\$2,694.14).

Section 3. Under the provisions of C. R. S. 1963, 88-1-15 the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud, hereby authorize the expenditure of funds in excess of the 1967 budget in the amount of Nine Thousand Dollars (\$9,000.00) under the United States Government Contract and Two Thousand Six Hundred Ninety-four Dollars and Fourteen Cents (\$2,694.14) for the new water line.

Section 4. The Board of Trustees herewith determines and designates that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and whereas, in the opinion of the Board of Trustees an emergency exists, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its final passage and adoption and publication.

The above ordinance was passed on first reading and adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud, Colorado, at its regular meeting held Tuesday, November 14, 1967, with 7/11 trustees voting for the adoption of this ordinance and No trustees voting against the adoption of this ordinance. That said vote therefore meets the requirement that the ordinance be adopted by two-thirds vote of the Board of Trustees.

The Town Clerk is hereby directed to send a certified copy of this Ordinance to be filed with the State Tax Commission and published in full one time in a newspaper having general circulation within the limits of the Town of Berthoud.
