

ORDINANCE NO. 391

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF AN EASEMENT OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD,
COLORADO, ALONG LAKE STREET.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF
BERTHOUD, COLORADO:

Section 1. The entire width of the Lake Street roadway between
the East boundary of the Colorado and Southern Railway Company Right-
of-Way and the West boundary of Highway 287 Right-of-way, except that
portion of said Lake Street that crosses an intersection with Second
Street, Berthoud, Colorado; be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. The Board of Trustees herewith finds, determines,
and declares that the above mentioned easement with the exception
withdrawn as above described is not needed and the convenience or
needs of the people will not in any way effected or impaired by
vacating said easement to the present owners of the land, for the
Town has no further need for said easement and the owners on both
sides of said easement have duly requested the Board of Trustees to
vacate the same.

Section 3. The Board of Trustees herewith determines and
designates that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate
preservation of the public peace, health and safety and whereas, in
the opinion of the Board of Trustees an emergency exist, this
ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days after its
final passage and adoption and publication.

The above ordinance was passed on first reading and adopted
by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud, Colorado, at its
regular meeting held Tuesday, April 11, 1967.
