

ORDINANCE NO. 476

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 17 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO, BY AMENDING SECTION 34 OF CHAPTER 17, CRIMINAL TRESPASS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1.

Whereas the Board of Trustees has determined that certain areas, both public and private, should be free from public access without invitation and unrestrained access poses a danger to the citizens personally and to their property.

Section 2.

Chapter 17 of the Municipal Code of the Town of Berthoud, Colorado, be and the same is hereby modified to read as follows:


17.34-1 CRIMINAL TRESPASS. It shall be unlawful and in violation hereof for a person to enter or remain in a dwelling or to enter and remain in or upon premises which are enclosed in a manner designed to exclude intruders or are fenced; or to enter or remain in or upon private premises without invitation; or to enter any motor vehicle.

17.34-2 CRIMINAL TRESPASS. It shall be unlawful and in violation hereof for a person to enter or remain upon any of the public parks of the Town of Berthoud known as Berthoud Park, Fickel Park or Robert's Lake Park during the hours from 11:00 P.M. to 6:00 A.M. unless such person is participating in or an observer of an activity which is either sponsored by the Town of Berthoud or an activity for which the Town Superintendant or Board of Trustees has issued a park permit.

Section 3.


The Board of Trustees herewith finds, determines and designates that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety; and whereas in the opinion of the Board of Trustees an emergency exists, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its final passage and adoption.
