

ORDINANCE NO. #465

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 442 CONCERNING THE REGULATION OF TRAFFIC AND ESTABLISHING ONE-WAY STREETS BY THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1.

That Schedule V, Section 26-5. One-Way Streets, of Ordinance No. 442 relative to the establishment of one-way streets by the Town of Berthoud, Colorado, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

In accordance with the provisions of Section 8-1, and when official signs are erected giving notice thereof, traffic shall move only in the direction indicated upon the following streets:

Name of Street	Portion affected (terminal limits)	Direction of traffic movement
9th Street	Massachusetts Ave. North to its termination as a public street at the Berthoud High School parking lot.	South
Alleyway $\frac{1}{2}$ block West of 9th St.	Mountain Avenue (Colo. 287) North to Massachusetts Ave.	North

Section 2.

The Board of Trustees herewith finds, determines and designates that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and the welfare of the citizens making use of the Berthoud High School; and whereas, in the opinion of the Board of Trustees an emergency exists, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately after its final passage and adoption.

This Ordinance was introduced, read, passed on first reading, and ordered published by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud at its regular meeting held this 13th day of March 1979.
