

ORDINANCE NO. #454

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 6, SUBSECTION 6.18 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1.

That Chapter 6, Subsection 6.18 of the Municipal Code of the Town of Berthoud, Colorado, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

6.18 IRRIGATION RESTRICTIONS. The use of water for sprinkling or irrigation of lawns and for horticultural purposes may be prohibited or restricted by order of the Board of Trustees. Such order shall be effective when notice thereof is published once in a newspaper of general circulation in the Town. Upon the publication of such notice, the sprinkling restrictions or prohibitions so prescribed shall take effect and any violation thereof may be punished by a fine of not more than \$300.00, or not more than ninety (90) days in jail, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 2.


The Board of Trustees herewith finds, determines and designates that because of the Town's limited supply of water, this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety; and whereas in the opinion of the Board of Trustees an emergency exists, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately after its final passage and adoption.

This Ordinance was introduced, read, passed on first reading and ordered published by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud at its regular meeting held this 26th day of September, 1978.
