

ORDINANCE NO. 446

AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING CHAPTER 6 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO, BY THE ADDITION OF SECTION 30; TAPPING FOR FIRE PROTECTION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1.

That Chapter 6 of the Municipal Code of the Town of Berthoud, Colorado, be and the same is hereby amended by the addition of Section 30 to read as follows:

Section 2.

6.30 - TAPPING FOR FIRE PROTECTION: It shall be unlawful for any person to tap into the water mains of the Town for the purpose of installing a fire protection sprinkling system without first having completed the following requirements:

(1) Submit two (2) copies of detailed written plans and specifications of the system and the name of the installed to the Town Manager;

(2) Upon receipt of written approval by the Town Manager, the system must be installed in accordance with the written plans and specifications as approved by the Town Manager at no cost to the Town. Final inspection and approval by the Town Manager must be received within 180 days after receipt of the first approval.


If a sprinkling system is installed without first complying with these procedures, the current applicable tap fee shall be charged to the property owner.

Section 3.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud herewith finds, determines and designates that this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after publication.


