

ORDINANCE NO. 443

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE VACATION OF A PORTION OF THE STREETS IN THE NORTHEAST ADDITION IN THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1. Purpose:

The purpose of this Ordinance is to coordinate and adjust the development of the municipality in accordance with present and future needs and promote the order, convenience, prosperity and general welfare.

Section 2. The following described property is hereby vacated:

All that portion of the roadway dedicated to public use by the recorded plat of the Northeast Addition to the Town of Berthoud, Colorado extending South from the South boundary of the County Road, also known as Bunyan Avenue, to the North boundary of Franklin Street, also known as Franklin Avenue, and extending forty feet (40') East from the East boundary of the Colorado and Southern Railroad as shown on the recorded plat of the Northeast Addition to the Town of Berthoud, County of Larimer, State of Colorado.

Section 3. Effective Date:

This Ordinance was introduced, read, and a hearing date set by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud at its meeting held the 14th day of February, 1978.

This Ordinance was read, passed and ordered published the 28 day of February, 1978 subsequent to the public hearing held the 28 day of February, 1978.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud herewith finds, determines and designates that this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after publication.
