

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 17 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO, BY AMENDING CHAPTER 17, SUBSECTION 17.30 RELATING TO THE OPEN DISPLAY OF FERMENTED MALT BEVERAGES AND ANY MALT, VINOUS OR SPIRITUOUS LIQUORS IN OR UPON ANY STREET, ALLEY OR OTHER PUBLIC WAY WITHIN THE TOWN.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1:

That Chapter 17, Subsection 17.30 of the Municipal Code of the Town of Berthoud be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

17.30 Open Display of Fermented Malt Beverages and any Malt, Vinous or Spirituous Liquors.

It shall be unlawful to drink or openly display any fermented malt beverages and any malt, vinous or spirituous liquors in or upon any street, alley or other public way within the Town. And it shall be unlawful to sell, serve, drink or openly display any fermented malt beverages and any malt, vinous or spirituous liquors in or upon any public building, public park or any other public place within the Town or upon the premises of any restaurant, lunch stand, store or other place of business within the Town, except at such places where the same may lawfully be sold or sold and served as provided by the laws of the State of Colorado, and at such times and places as expressly authorized by the Town Board to meet the requirements of the community and encourage the use of the Town's parks and other amusement centers for community welfare.

Section 2:

This Ordinance was introduced, read, passed on first reading and ordered published by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud at its meeting held this 11th day of May, 1976.
