

ORDINANCE NO. 415

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS IN EXCESS OF THE 1975 BUDGET.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1:

During the year 1975, the Town was compelled to purchase sixty-five (65) units of diversion water to safeguard the health and safety of the residents of the Town of Berthoud, which it did not anticipate purchasing at the time the budget was adopted in 1974.

Section 2:

Under the provisions of CRS '73-29-1-111 and 29-1-114, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud hereby authorizes the expenditures of \$19,331.00 from the Contingency Fund, and \$7,850.00 from the Raw Water Fund, from the 1975 budget.

Section 3:

The Board of Trustees herewith determines and designates that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety; and whereas, in the opinion of the Board of Trustees, an emergency exists, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately after its final passage and adoption and publication.

The above Ordinance was passed on first reading and adopted by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud, Colorado, at its regular meeting held Tuesday, December 9, 1975, with 5 trustees voting for the adoption of this Ordinance, and 0 trustees voting against the adoption of this Ordinance. That said vote therefore meets the requirement that the Ordinance be adopted by three-fourths vote of the Board of Trustees.

The Town Clerk is hereby directed to send a certified copy of this Ordinance to be filed with the State Division of Local Government and published in full one time in a newspaper having general circulation within the limits of the Town of Berthoud.
