

ORDINANCE NO. 413

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE VACATING OF A PORTION OF 7TH STREET IN THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1. Purpose:

The purpose of this Ordinance is to coordinate and adjust the development of the municipality in accordance with present and future needs and promote the order, convenience, prosperity and general welfare.


Section 2. Vacating Prior Appropriation:

The prior appropriation of the land hereinafter described to-wit:

That portion of Bimson Avenue in Rocky Mountain Addition to the Town of Berthoud, West of the West right-of-way line of 7th Street and East of a line extended between the Northwest corner of Lot 5, Block 5, said Rocky Mountain Addition and the Southwest corner of Lot 20, Block 4, said Rocky Mountain Addition to the Town of Berthoud; and that portion South of the South right-of-way line of Bimson Avenue and North of a line extended between the Southeast corner of Lot 1, Block 5, said Rocky Mountain Addition and the Southwest corner of Lot 12, Block 6, said Rocky Mountain Addition.


