

ORDINANCE NO. 408

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE VACATING OF A PORTION OF ALLEY IN ROCKY MOUNTAIN ADDITION IN THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1. Purpose:

The purpose of this Ordinance is to coordinate and adjust the development of the municipality in accordance with present and future needs and promote the order, convenience, prosperity and general welfare.

Section 2. Vacating Prior Appropriation:

The prior appropriation of the land hereinafter described to-wit:


That portion of a 10 foot alley adjacent to the West 15 feet of Lot 5, and Lots 6 through 12, Block 5, Rocky Mountain Addition to the Town of Berthoud, Larimer County, Colorado,

is hereby vacated and terminated.

Section 3. Effective Date:


The Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud herewith finds, determines and designates that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety; and whereas, in the opinion of the Board of Trustees, an emergency exists, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately after its final passage, adoption and publication.

This Ordinance was introduced, read, passed on first reading and ordered published by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud at its meeting held this 11th day of Feb., 1975.
