

ORDINANCE NO. 407

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 400 CONCERNING CHAPTER 17 SUBSECTION 17.37 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1.

That Ordinance No. 400, concerning ^{Chapter 17} Subsection 17.37 of the Municipal Code of the Town of Berthoud, Colorado be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

17.37 RAILROADS - STREET OBSTRUCTION. It shall be unlawful for any person to obstruct the free passage of any street or public highway within the Town by means of any railroad car, locomotive or other railway vehicle, or to permit the same to remain in or upon any street or public highway across which any railroad may be constructed or operated for a period exceeding five minutes at any one time. Provided that the provisions of this section shall not apply to trains traveling continuously in the same direction over said street or public highway.

Section 2.

The Board of Trustees herewith finds, determines and designates that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety; and whereas in the opinion of the Board of Trustees an emergency exists, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately after its final passage and adoption.

This Ordinance was introduced, read, passed on first reading and ordered published by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud at its regular meeting held this 14th day of January, 1975.
