

ORDINANCE NO. 595

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 3.1-1 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO:

Section 1.

Section 3.1-1 (Compensation) is hereby amended to read as follows:

3.1-1 COMPENSATION. Each member of the Board of Trustees shall be paid \$60.00 per month for serving as a member of the Board of Trustees. In the event the Mayor or a Trustee serves only a portion of a month, their compensation shall be adjusted in proportion with the period of time which they actually served. In addition to the foregoing monthly retainer fee to be paid, each board member shall receive an additional \$15.00 for every special board meeting or board study session which he or she attends. The compensation of those board members elected prior to April 1, 1986 shall not be affected by this amendment.

Section 2. Emergency Clause.

The board has determined that the compensation presently being paid to the Board of Trustees as established prior to 1967 is no longer either an inducement to serve nor reasonable compensation for the time, expertise and risks involved in providing the town with their service as members of the Board of Trustees. The Board of Trustees has determined that this increase is necessary to ensure a continued source of competent members and to encourage those members of the community who could otherwise not afford to serve as board members to actively participate in governing the town.

Section 3. Effective Date.

This ordinance was introduced and read at the regular meeting of the Board of Trustees on this 25th day of March, 1986 with members voting for, members voting against and members abstaining as an emergency ordinance which shall immediately be in full force and effect and published according to statutes.
