

ORDINANCE NO. 546

AN ORDINANCE SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 17 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO, BY ADDING SUBSECTION 17.44, RAILROAD - SPEED LIMITS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO:


Section 1.

That Chapter 17 of the Municipal Code of the Town of Berthoud, Colorado be and the same is hereby modified to incorporate Subsection 17.44 which reads as follows:

17.44 RAILROADS - RAILROAD SPEED LIMITS. It shall be unlawful for any person to move, propel or run any railroad tractor, locomotive or other railway vehicle at a speed greater than 30 miles per hour or any railroad track in the Town of Berthoud, provided that after the first car has passed Welch Avenue going South on Bunyan Avenue going North, it may increase its speed to one which is reasonable and prudent under the circumstances.

Section 2. Effective Date

This Ordinance was introduced and read at the meeting the 13th day of September, 1983 and a public hearing and second reading was set for September 27, 1983. At its regular meeting on September 27, 1983 this Ordinance was read, passed and ordered published by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud.
