

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ZONING ORDINANCE NUMBER 336 TO CREATE A SEVEN MEMBER PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION AND TO ALLOW FOR THE DESIGNATION OF ALTERNATE MEMBERS ON THE PLANNING AND ZONING COMMISSION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1.

Chapter 16 of Ordinance Number 336 is hereby amended to read as follows:

16-1-2 Member of Commission. The Town Planning Commission shall consist of seven (7) members as follows: one member of said commission to be the Mayor; one member to be a Trustee selected by the Mayor; one of the Town's administrative officials selected by the Mayor; a Trustee selected by the Board of Trustees; and three members to be appointed by the Board of Trustees. All members of the Commission shall be bona fide residents of the municipality for the entire tenure of their membership on the Planning Commission. The term of each appointed member shall be six years or until his successor takes office, except that the respective terms of the members first appointed shall be as follows: Three (3) members for a term of two (2) years, two (2) members for a term of four (4) years and two (2) members for a term of six (6) years. The respective terms of the members first appointed shall be fixed and designated by the Board at the time of appointment. The terms of the members of the Planning Commission may be reduced by majority vote of the Board of Trustees

Section 2.

Chapter 16 of Ordinance Number 336 is hereby amended by the addition of Section 16-1-9 to read as follows:

16-1-9 Designation of Alternate Members. The Board of Trustees may appoint three (3) alternate members to the Planning and Zoning Commission, one alternate for each of the three (3) members appointed by the Board of Trustees. The Mayor may designate an alternate member to serve in the absence of the Trustee receiving the primary appointment. The Mayor pro tem shall serve as a member of the Planning and Zoning Commission in the absence of the Mayor.


Section 3. Effective Date


The Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud herewith finds, determines, and designates that this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after publication.
