

ORDINANCE NO. 531

AN ORDINANCE TO REPLAT WILSON SUBDIVISION BEING A SUBDIVISION OF A PORTION OF THE CAPITOL HILL ADDITION TO THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO.

WHEREAS the applicants have submitted their application for replatting and paid the attendant fee and said application has been reviewed by the Town Superintendent and the Planning and Zoning Commission.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1:

That the following described property, being a portion of the Town of Berthoud, Larimer County, Colorado, being more particularly described as follows:

Lots 21 through 24, Block 1, Capitol Hill Addition to the Town of Berthoud,

is hereby replatted as follows:


Lots 1 and 2, Wilson Subdivision, a portion of Lots 21 through 24, Block 1, Capitol Hill Addition to the Town of Berthoud.

Section 2. Effective Date


The Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud herewith finds, determines, and designates that this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after publication.

This Ordinance was introduced and read and a public hearing set for April 13, 1982, by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud at its meeting held this 23rd day of March, 1982. After a public hearing, this Ordinance was read, passed, and ordered published by the Board of Trustees at its meeting this 13th day of April, 1982.
