

ORDINANCE NO. 516

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 26-5 OF THE MODEL TRAFFIC CODE FOR THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1.

That Section 26-5 of the Model Traffic Code of the Town of Berthoud, Colorado be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

SCHEDULE V

Sec. 26-5. One-Way Streets. In accordance with the provisions of Section 8-1, and when official signs are erected giving notice thereof, traffic shall move only in the direction indicated upon the following streets:

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Portion Affected (terminal limits)</u>	<u>Direction of Traffic Movement</u>
Alleyway	located $\frac{1}{2}$ block W. of 9th St. between Mtn. and Mass. Ave.	North

Section 2.

The Board of Trustees has determined that, in view of the pedestrian and bicycle problems which will exist when the school year commences, the safety, health and welfare of the citizens of the Town of Berthoud necessitates that this Ordinance take effect immediately.

This Ordinance was introduced, read, passed on first reading and ordered published by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud at its regular meeting held this 25th day of August, 1981.
