

ORDINANCE NO. 515

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE XXVI OF THE MODEL TRAFFIC CODE OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO, BY LIMITING AND PROHIBITING PARKING ON CERTAIN STREETS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1.

That Article XXVI, Section 26-8, of the Model Traffic Code of the Town of Berthoud, Colorado, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Article XXVI, Sec. 26-8. Parking prohibited at all times on certain streets. - In accordance with the provisions of section 12-2, and when official signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall at any time park a vehicle upon any of the following described streets or parts of streets:

<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Portion Affected</u>
5th Street and Welch Avenue	South 700 ft. along the West edge of 5th Street and West 189 feet along the South edge of Welch Ave. both commencing at the Southwest corner of 5th Street and Welch Ave.

Section 2.

That Article XXVI, Section 26-9, of the Model Traffic Code of the Town of Berthoud, Colorado, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:


Article XXVI, Sec. 26-9. Parking time limited on certain streets. - In accordance with the provisions of section 12-2, and when official signs are erected giving notice thereof, no person shall park a vehicle for a period of time longer than 15 minutes upon any of the streets or parts of streets as follows:


<u>Name of Street</u>	<u>Portion Affected</u>
4th Street	South 45 feet along the East edge of 4th Street commencing at the Southeast corner of 4th Street and Massachusetts Avenue.

Section 3.

The Board of Trustees herewith finds, determines, and designates that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate necessity of ensuring the safety of the people using the Town's park and to promote safe and efficient use of the streets in the business areas of the Town. And whereas in the opinion of the Board of Trustees an emergency exists, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately after its final passage and adoption.

This Ordinance was introduced, read, and passed at the regular meeting of the Board of Trustees held the 14th day of April, 1981.
