

ORDINANCE NO. 512

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURES OF FUNDS IN EXCESS OF THE 1980 BUDGET.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO, THAT:

Section 1.

Whereas, in November 1980, the Town of Berthoud experienced several unforeseen water breaks due to increased pressure from a feeder line break at the filter plant; and

Whereas, the total cost of repairs in said lines and overtime pay to employees for such breaks exceeds the amount appropriated in the 1980 budget, and the Board of Trustees has determined that these expenditures should be paid during 1980.

Section 2.

The section of Ordinance No. 478 denominated "Berthoud Municipal Water Department" is hereby amended to read as follows:

Berthoud Municipal Water Department

- a. Revenue \$158,060.
- 1. Water rent
 - 2. Water taps
 - 3. Interest from Investments
 - 4. Transfer from Capitol Improvement fund
- b. Expenditures \$158,060.
- 1. All expenses incurred in operation of the Water Department to include salaries.

Section 3.

Whereas, a surplus exists in the amount of funds appropriated for expenditures within the Capitol Improvement Fund, the Board hereby designates that the surplus be applied to payment of Water Fund expenditures exceeding the 1980 budget.


Section 4.

The Board of Trustees herewith determines and designates that these expenditures could not have been accurately forecast at the time the budget was drafted and that these expenditures are necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety and whereas, in the opinion of the Board of Trustees an emergency exists, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon its final passage and adoption.


Section 6.
