

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING THE TAXES FOR THE YEAR 1993 TO DEFRAID THE COSTS OF MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 1993 AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1993.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud, Colorado, has adopted a budget for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 1993 and ending December 31, 1993: and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that the proper Mill Levy upon each dollar of the assessed valuation of all taxable property within the Town is 8.030 Mills;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO:

Section 1. That for the purposes of defraying the expenses of the General Fund of Berthoud, Colorado, during the fiscal year beginning January 1, 1993 and ending on December 31, 1993, there is hereby levied a tax of 7.465 Mills upon each dollar of the total assessed valuation of all taxable property within the Town of Berthoud for the year 1993.


Section 2. That for the purposes of the Library Fund expenses of the Town of Berthoud during the 1993 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of .5 Mills upon each dollar of the total assessed valuation of taxable property within the Town of Berthoud for the year 1993.

Section 3. That for the purposes of Abatements and Refunds during the 1993 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of .065 Mills upon each dollar of the total assessed valuation of all taxable property within the Town of Berthoud for the year 1993.

Section 4. That the Town Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify to the County Commissioners of Larimer County, Colorado, the total tax levy for the Town of Berthoud, Colorado, as is herein set forth.

Section 5. The Board of Trustees has determined that an emergency exists which jeopardizes the fiscal stability and welfare of the citizens of the Town of Berthoud and this ordinance shall, therefore, be effective upon adoption.
