

ORDINANCE NO 665

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 640, CONCERNING MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS, REQUIRING WRITE-IN CANDIDATES TO FILE AN AFFIDAVIT PRIOR TO ELECTION AND PROVIDING THAT ELECTIONS MAY BE CANCELED UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES, ALL OTHER PROVISIONS IN ORDINANCE NO. 640 SHALL REMAIN UNALTERED BY THIS AMENDMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1.

Section 1. of Ordinance No. 640 is amended to read as follows:

Write-in Candidate - Affidavit: No write-in vote for any municipal office shall be counted unless an affidavit of intent has been filed with the clerk by the person whose name is written in prior to TWENTY (20) days before the day of the election indicating that such person desires the office and is qualified to assume the duties of that office if elected.

Section 2.


Section 2. of Ordinance No. 640 is amended to read as follows:

Election May be Canceled - When: If the only matter before the voters is the election of persons to office and if, at the close of business on the NINETEENTH (19) day before the election, there are not more candidates than offices to be filled at such elections, including candidates filing affidavits of intent, the clerk, if instructed by resolution of the Board of Trustees either before or after such date, shall cancel the elections and by resolution declare the candidates elected. If so provided by ordinance, upon such declaration the candidates shall be deemed elected. Notice of such cancellation shall be published, if possible, in order to inform the electors of the municipality, and notice of such cancellation shall be posted at each polling place and in not less than one other public place.

Section 3.

Section 3. Effective Date: This ordinance was introduced, read, approved, adopted, signed and ordered published in full at its meeting this 14th day of January, 1992, to be effective February 13, 1992.
