

ORDINANCE NO. 629

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 626 WHICH LEVIED THE TAXES FOR THE YEAR 1989 TO DEFRAY THE COSTS OF MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 1989 AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1989.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud, Colorado, has adopted a budget for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 1989, and ending December 31, 1989; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees, has determined that the proper Mil Levy upon each dollar of the assessed valuation of all taxable property within the Town is 5.529 mils; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO:

Section 1. That for the purposes of defraying the expenses of the General Fund of Berthoud, Colorado, during the fiscal year beginning January 1, 1989 and ending on December 31, 1989, there is hereby levied a tax of 5.529 mils upon each dollar of the total assessed valuation of all taxable property within the Town of Berthoud for the year 1989.

Section 2. The Board of Trustees has determined that an emergency exists which jeopardizes the fiscal stability and welfare of the citizens of the Town of Berthoud and this Ordinance shall, therefore, be effective upon adoption.

At the meeting held on December 13, 1988, the Board of Trustees voted to enact this Ordinance with the following results:
