

ORDINANCE NO. 628

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURES OF FUNDS IN EXCESS OF THE 1988 BUDGET.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO THAT:

Section 1. WHEREAS, in October 1988, the Town of Berthoud, determined that the installation of a Boat Clarifier, at the Wastewater Treatment Plant, would clarify the Towns, wastewater up to a flow rate of 400,000 gallons per day (278 gpm)

WHEREAS, a surplus exists in the amount of funds available for expenditure within the Sewer Capital Improvement Fund, the Board hereby designates \$60,000 of the surplus be applied to the purchase of the Boat Clarifier.

Section 2. WHEREAS, in November 1988, the Town of Berthoud determined that the Recreation Department did not allocate adequate funds for the purchase of equipment. The additional expenditure, for the necessary equipment, would necessitate exceeding the General Fund Capital Improvement Budget.

WHEREAS, a surplus exists in the General Fund Capital Improvement Budget, the Board hereby designates \$12,000 of the surplus, be applied to the purchase of recreation equipment.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees determines and designates that these expenditures could not have been accurately forecast at the time the Budget was drafted and that these expenditures are necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety.

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Board of Trustees an emergency exists, which jeopardizes the fiscal welfare of the Town and would affect the health and safety of its citizens. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon its final passage and adoption.

At the meeting held on December 13, 1988, the Board of Trustees voted to enact this Ordinance with the following results:
