

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 566, WHICH ESTABLISHED A PERMIT SYSTEM FOR THE RECREATIONAL USE OF ROBERT'S LAKE.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the town of Berthoud has determined that the use of Robert's Lake for aquatic purposes may jeopardize the health, welfare and safety of the residents of the Town because of the use of aeration equipment in the lake, NOW THEREFORE:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO THAT CHAPTER 17 OF THE BERTHOUD MUNICIPAL CODE BE AMENDED BY THE REPEAL AND REENACTMENT OF 17.45 WHICH SHALL READ IN ITS ENTIRETY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Use of Robert's Lake Prohibited.

a. It is unlawful to trespass in or on Robert's Lake without first obtaining the prior written permission of the Town Administrator. Permission may be granted where it can be reasonably be shown that the use of the lake will not create any additional liability to the Town, to the property owners adjacent to the lake and to the users themselves.

b. A violation of this ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of up to \$300.00 or imprisonment for up to 90 days or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 2. Effective Date and Emergency Clause:

The Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud herewith finds, determines and designates that this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately after its passage because an emergency exists which jeopardizes the health, safety and welfare of the Town of Berthoud.

At its meeting June 14, 1988, this Ordinance was read, passed and ordered published by the Board of Trustees.
