

ORDINANCE NO. 622

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE MINIMUM FINE SCHEDULE FOR THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, COUNTY OF LARIMER, STATE OF COLORADO.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO.

Section 1.

Section 2 of the Minimum Fine Schedule regarding the following Berthoud Municipal Ordinance Violations is amended in its entirety to read:

6.15	Wasting water	\$ 22.00
6.18	Sprinkling restrictions	22.00
15.12	Removal of snow and ice (first offense only)	17.00
17.35	Loitering of minors (first offense only)	17.00
18.4-1(d)	Number of dogs (first offense only)	22.00
18.2-2	Dogs must be licensed (first offense only)	17.00
18.4-1(a)	Dog under control (first offense only)	17.00

All remaining Municipal Code violations shall remain as previously adopted.

Section 2. Emergency Clause

The Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud herewith finds that the adoption of the amended Berthoud Municipal Ordinance Violations of the Minimum Fine Schedule is necessary to ensure the health, safety and welfare of the Town and an emergency exists justifying the adoption of this ordinance to take effect immediately upon passage this 12th day of April, 1988 by a vote of 7 for and 0 opposed.
