

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 17, MUNICIPAL OFFENSES, OF THE BERTHOUD MUNICIPAL CODE WITH SECTION 17.34.1, MINOR IN POSSESSION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO, THAT CHAPTER 17 OF THE BERTHOUD MUNICIPAL CODE IS HEREBY AMENDED WITH THE ADDITION OF THE FOLLOWING SECTION:

CHAPTER 17

MUNICIPAL OFFENSES

Section 1.

17.34.1 MINOR IN POSSESSION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE.

1. It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of twenty-one (21) years to be in the possession of any fermented malt beverages in excess of 3.2% alcohol, any vinous or any spiritous liquors, whether in a container which is open or unopened, in or upon any street, alley or other place open to the public within the town of Berthoud.

2. It shall be unlawful for any person who is eighteen (18) years of age after July 29, 1987 to be in the possession of any fermented malt beverages containing 3.2% alcohol, whether in a container which is open or unopened, in or upon any street, alley or other place open to the public within the town of Berthoud.

Section 2. Penalties

It shall be unlawful to violate any provision of this ordinance and upon conviction the guilty party may be sentenced to a \$300.00 fine, ninety (90) days in jail or both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 3. Effective Date

This ordinance was introduced and read and a public hearing set for January 26, 1988, by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud at its meeting held on this 12th day of January, 1988. After a public hearing, this ordinance was read, passed, and ordered published by the Board of Trustees at its meeting this 26th day of January, 1988.
