

ORDINANCE NO. 614

Series of 1987

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING THE TAXES FOR THE YEAR 1988 TO DEFRAY THE COSTS OF MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING JANUARY 1, 1988, AND ENDING DECEMBER 31, 1988.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud has adopted the annual budget in accordance with the Local Government Budget Law, on November 24, 1987, and;

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for general operating expenses is \$81,668 and;

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for bonds and interest is \$43,082, and;

WHEREAS, the amount of money necessary to balance the budget for the Library is \$8,332, and;

WHEREAS, the 1988 valuation for assessment for the Town of Berthoud as certified by the County Assessor is 17,003,470.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES, THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, COLORADO:

Section 1. That the purpose of meeting all general operating expenses of the Town of Berthoud during the 1988 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 4.901 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the Town for the year 1988.

Section 2. That for the purpose of meeting all bonds and interest of the Town of Berthoud during the 1988 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of 2.474 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the Town for the year 1988.

Section 3. That for the purpose of meeting all the Library fund expenses of the Town of Berthoud during the 1988 budget year, there is hereby levied a tax of .5 mills upon each dollar of the total valuation for assessment of all taxable property within the Town for the year 1988

Section 4. That the Town Clerk, Orahbelle Patterson, is hereby authorized and directed to immediately certify to the County Commissioners of Larimer County, Colorado, the mill levies for the Town of Berthoud as hereinabove determined and set.

Section 5. The Board of Trustees has determined that an emergency exists which jeopardizes the fiscal stability and welfare of the citizens of the Town of Berthoud.

At the meeting held on December 1, 1987, the Board of Trustees unanimously voted to enact this Ordinance with the following results:
