

ORDINANCE NO. 777

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE 2, SECTION 18-2-120 PARAGRAPH (B) OF THE ANIMAL ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, COUNTY OF LARIMER, STATE OF COLORADO, WHICH REGULATES THE CARE, TREATMENT, CONTROL, IMPOUNDMENT, TYPES AND NUMBERS OF ANIMALS WITHIN THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO:

Article 2: LICENSES

Section 18-2-120 (B) Application and term of license, is hereby amended to read as follows:


B. The initial license and any renewal license issued under this Section shall be valid until January 1st of the year following issuance of the license. In the event the license is issued after July 1st of any year, only half the license fee shall be due.

Effective Date:


The Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud herewith finds, determines and designates that this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after publication.
