

ORDINANCE NO. 710

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 684 SPECIFICALLY REPEALING THE WATER DEDICATION ORDINANCE NO. 350 OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that Ordinance No. 684 is intended to control the dedication of water to the Town of Berthoud;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1.

Section 2. of Ordinance 684 is hereby amended with the addition of subsection (f) which shall read as follows:

(f) All ordinances or portions of ordinances specifically in conflict herewith and in particular section 2., subsection (1) of ordinance no. 350 are hereby repealed and superseded by the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 2. Emergency Clause and Effective Date:

At the time that Ordinance No. 684 was enacted it was the intention of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud that this ordinance was intended to be the sole basis for calculating the amount of raw water due to the Town of Berthoud as a result of development of real property it is therefore necessary to ensure that the intentions of the Board of Trustees regarding raw water dedication are specifically and clearly stated.

The Board of Trustees finds, determines, and declares that the repeal of Ordinance No. 350 is necessary to the welfare of the Town of Berthoud.

This Ordinance was introduced, read, passed and ordered published by the Board of Trustees at its meeting this 8th day of November, 1994, to become effective upon adoption.
