

ORDINANCE NO. 709

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NUMBER 684 TO ESTABLISH ALTERNATIVES FOR PAYING/CALCULATING THE AMOUNT DUE FOR WATER DEDICATION FEES TO THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO

WHEREAS the Board of Trustees has determined that in appropriate circumstances the imposition of the water dedication fee upon an existing water user may be unequitable;

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that properties served by water taps are presumed to have paid for their raw water over the period of their usage;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF BERTHOUD, LARIMER COUNTY, COLORADO:

Section 1.

Section 2 of Ordinance 684 is hereby amended with the addition of subsection (e) which shall read as follows:


(e) When a reevaluation of the usage by a water user would require the water user to provide or purchase raw water, the water user may, by written petition, apply to the Board of Trustees for a partial or total waiver of the raw water requirements based upon the fact that the water user's preexisting usage is equivalent in volume and purpose to the anticipated future usage.

Section 2. Effective Date:


The Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud herewith finds, determines and designates that this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty (30) days after publication.

At its meeting September 27, 1994, this ordinance was read and a public hearing was set by the Board of Trustees of the Town of Berthoud for its meeting held on the 11th day of October, 1994. After the public hearing, the Ordinance was passed and ordered published by the Board of Trustees at its meeting this 11th day of October, 1994.
